The REACH Regulation (CE) n. 1907/2006, concerns the Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of chemical substances and has in all respects entered into force on 1 June 2008.

In accordance with the provisions of REACH, anyone who produces or imports from non-SEE countries a substance as such or as it is contained in a mixture, in quantities equal to or greater than one ton per year, is required to register it with the ECHA.

Article 2 of REACH provides exemptions from the registration obligation. The SEPIOLITE product is a mineral present in nature not subjected to chemical modifications among the substances listed in Annex V.7 exempt from registration.

In accordance with article 31 paragraph 1 of REACH, whoever supplies a substance or a mixture must send the recipient a Safety Data Sheet:

- If the substance or mixture meets the criteria for classification as dangerous according to CLP Regulation (CE) no. 1272/2008;
- When a substance is PBT or vPvB;
- When a substance is included in the Candidate List.

In accordance with article 31 paragraph 3 of REACH, whoever supplies a mixture not classified as dangerous sends a Safety Data Sheet upon request of the recipient if it contains:

- In an individual concentration equal or greater than 1% by weight, at least one substance which presents dangers to human health or the environment; or
- In an individual concentration equal or greater than 0.1% by weight at least one substance which is PBT or vPvB or which has been included in the Candidate List; or
- A substance for which Community legislation sets exposure limits in the workplace.

The SEPIOLITE product is a mixture of sepiolite and dolomite. The product is not classified as dangerous according to CLP and does not fall under the cases indicated in paragraphs 1 and 3 of article 31 of REACH, therefore it does not require a Safety Data Sheet.
